



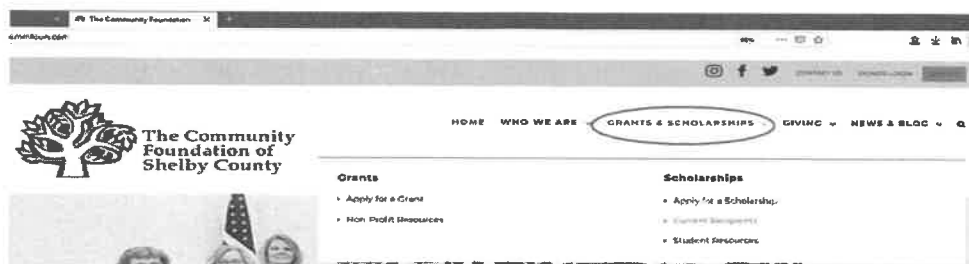

Our Scholarships program for 2021 will....

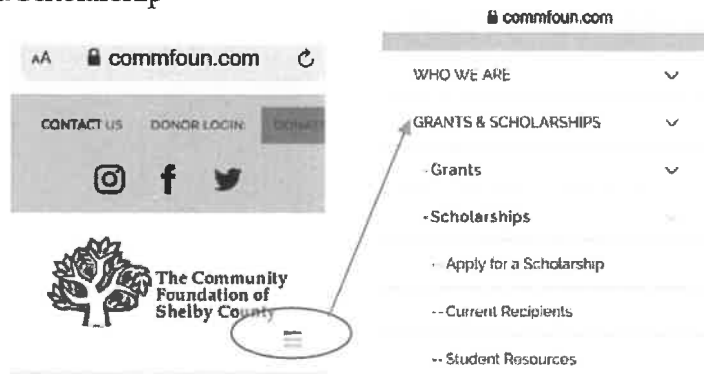
- Award approximately 170 scholarships totaling more than \$289,000.
- The Community Foundation Scholarship application is completely online at www.commfoun.com
- The deadline for most of the high school senior awards is **February 11, 2021**.
- The deadline for the Skills Scholarship is **March 11, 2021**.
- The deadline for scholarships for adults, current college students and some high school seniors is **June 3, 2021**.

How can I prepare to complete the application?

- Please prepare this information before you start:
 - In what school district do you live?
 - In what county do you live?
 - What is your cumulative grade point average?
- Gather this information:
 - Your high school and/or college transcript
 - High school students may electronically request their transcript from their guidance office from within the application.
 - A list of school and community service activities.
 - Letters of Recommendation (1-3 letters are required) - These maybe electronically requested from within the application.
 - Your EFC (Expected Family Contribution) from the FAFSA form. Not all scholarships require this information.
 - College cost of attendance information. This information is available in the Admissions or Financial Aid sections of your college's website. All scholarships require the recipient attend an accredited college, university, or technical school.
- Find the link to the online scholarship application in the Scholarship section of our website at www.commfoun.com. It is located under Scholarships and Grants. This is how it will look on a desktop/laptop PC:



If you are using a mobile device, you can find it under the three yellow bars at the top right corner of the page. Click on the three yellow bars and the menu will dropdown. Hit the dropdown arrows (not the words) to open the next menu showing "Grants & Scholarships," then "Scholarships," then click on the words "Apply for a Scholarship"



- Our application is a matching application, meaning it will ask you a series of questions that will 'match' you with scholarships for which you may be eligible. No information gathered during our process is used for any purpose except to consider you for a scholarship.

Directions to work through the application:

- Begin by clicking the green Begin Search button. After you complete the matching questions, a group of scholarships will appear. A little information on each scholarship appears. Click the box for each scholarship that you wish to apply. Then click the green 'save to my applications'. You will now need to create an account.
- Once you have created your account, you will find a listing of 'My Applications' in the upper right hand corner.
- Click on your first scholarship and start working on it. Make sure each application you open is starting on page 1. If not, go to the Instructions area on the right hand side and click 'Instructions'.
- If you need to stop working on the application and come back to it later, save and log out under your name in the top right hand corner.
- When you log back in and click on the scholarship application, click the green 'Edit Application' button in the right hand column.
- After you submit your first application, go to the 'My Applications' in the upper right corner to start working on your next application.

High school students - You may choose to either request your transcript from your guidance office or upload your own. If you have taken College Credit Plus courses for college credit and they are NOT shown on your high school transcript, please contact our office to add your college grades.

College students - Please manually upload your transcript or advising report, which includes grades for each class. This does not need to be an 'official' transcript; your advising report is acceptable. Personally written or typed grade information will not be accepted.

* A list of school and community service activities

* Letters of recommendation: 1-3 letters are required. We recommend you submit more than one. Your application will NOT be given to the selection committee unless we have received, by the deadline date, at least one letter of recommendation. The application provides you three options to submit each letter of recommendation.

* Your EFC (Expected Family Contribution) report number from the FAFSA. The FAFSA website is www.FAFSA.ed.gov. We do have some scholarships that DO NOT require this information.

* College cost information. This information is found on your college's website, often in the Admissions or Financial Aid section.
NOTE: All scholarships require the recipient attend an accredited college, university, or technical school.

The part of the application that will not allow you to submit will show in the right column in red. Click on each red area. The page containing unfinished question(s) will open, allowing you to complete the missing information. Then, look for the Submit button at the bottom of the page and click. Once submitted, go back to your My Applications area and start the next application.

Remember, each application must be submitted by clicking the Submit button at the end of each application.

What to do if you are unable to click the Submit button on the Matching Questions or the Unique Application:

1. Scroll all the way to the bottom of the application and look for a button that says NEXT.
2. Click the button and it will take you to the next page of the application.
3. On this page you will be able to click the SUBMIT button to submit your scholarship.

Logging Back in to Complete an Application:

When you log back in and click on the scholarship application, click the green 'Edit Application' button in the right hand column.

After you submit your first application, go to the 'My Applications' in the upper right corner to start working on your next application.

Letters of Recommendation:

A word of caution: Your application is not complete without the submission of at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, advisor, employer or other non-family reference. You can submit the application without any letter attached, but if the Community Foundation of Shelby County does not have a recommendation letter by the application deadline, your application will not be considered for scholarships.

You have three options to submit a letter of recommendation:

1. Attach a letter to your application by uploading it. (shown on the screenshot above)
2. You or your recommender can mail, email or deliver a letter to the Community Foundation by the deadline. We will attach the letter to your application.
3. You can enter a recommender's email address and the online application system will automatically send an email requesting a letter of recommendation.

We encourage you to have more than one recommendation in case one of your recommenders fails to submit by the deadline. It is your responsibility to ensure there is at least one letter submitted. Letters can give information about you that might not be obvious on your application. Besides, one of your recommendation letters might appeal to the scholarship selection committee and it might tip the decision in your favor!

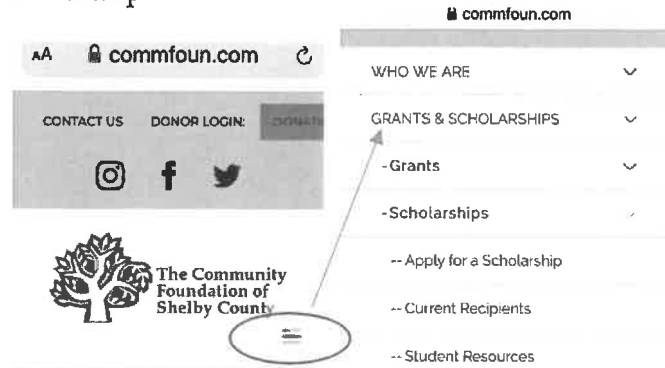

All scholarships require the recipient attend an accredited college, university, or technical school.

- ◆ Houston High School valedictorians and salutatorians and Sidney High School students ranked 1 and 2.

Scott F. Barker Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A Sidney High School graduating senior who will pursue a Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic achievement, financial need, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ *Awards for 2020: Three \$1,250 scholarships.*

Davis-Blackford Families Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors with a GPA of no less than 2.0 pursuing a Bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to an Education major, however, if no applicants are Education majors, the award may go to a qualified student pursuing another major. Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, community and school service, and recommendations
- ◆ *Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship.*

Marty Bowman Football Academic Scholarship Not part of the CFSC application.

- ◆ Sidney High School football players who meet academic standards

Thomas E. Given Family Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A Sidney High School senior who resides within Shelby County. Must be enrolling in a technical school, college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, leadership and character as evidenced by community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ *Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship, renewable for up to three (3) additional years.*

Larry Hawkins Family Scholarship – High School Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A Sidney High School senior or alumnus entering college for the first time. Only individuals attaining a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and enrolling in an adult education school, trade school, or a 2-year or 4-year college or university, located within the state of Ohio, in the coming academic year are eligible. Coursework completed online need not be from an institution located in the state of Ohio. Individuals who are enrolling in college for the first time and have not been enrolled in high school within the last three years shall be excluded from the GPA requirement.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ *Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship.*

Kauffman Family Foundation Scholarship Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ High School seniors at Anna, Fairlawn, Houston, Lehman Catholic, Minster, and Sidney with a high school GPA from 3.0 to 3.95 that are enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Academic achievement, financial need, recommendations, and community service.
- ◆ *Award for 2021: Various awards totaling \$8,000*

Kiwanis Club of Sidney Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Seniors at Sidney High School, Lehman Catholic High School or Sidney Christian Academy who are residents of the Sidney City Schools district. Must have a high school GPA of no less than 3.5 and plan to pursue an Associates or Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, school and community service, financial need, recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: Various scholarship awards totaling \$10,000**

Kiwanis Key Club Scholarship Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Sidney High School Key Club Members who are pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university in the coming academic year are eligible.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, financial need, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship.**

William A. Ross, Jr., Family Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ High school seniors who are Shelby County residents and attend Sidney High School or Lehman High School and wish to pursue a Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, recommendations, and quality of the application
- ◆ **Awards for 2021: \$1,200 in scholarships for seniors at each Sidney High School and Lehman High School**

Ruese Insurance Agency Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ High school seniors who attend Sidney High School, Christian Academy School in Sidney, Ohio or Lehman Catholic High School in Sidney, Ohio and wish to pursue an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. Students must have maintained a GPA of 3.0.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Awards for 2021: Three \$1,000 scholarship for seniors at each Sidney High School, Christian Academy School, and Lehman Catholic High School.**

Sidney High School Alumni Scholarship Fund (High School Seniors) Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need; academic ability; community, religious, and school service; recommendations. Must be enrolling in a trade school or pursuing a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,000 to a Sidney High School senior.**

Woody Sturm and Sturm Family Scholarship Fund – General Scholarship Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors who participated on the SHS Football team for no less than their junior and senior years of high school.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited college or university pursuing a Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Number of years on the SHS Football team, character, work ethic, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,000 to a Sidney High School senior.**

Stephen W. Weadock Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors. Student must have maintain a GPA of at least 3.5
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic achievement, demonstrated community and school service and recommendations. Must be enrolling in a trade school or pursuing a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,500 to a Sidney High School senior.**

Additional Multi-District, Major-specific and Miscellaneous Scholarships

Agriculture Related

Harry Emley and Mary Joslin Bennett Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A high school senior who resides in and attends a school within Shelby County and who wishes to study an agriculture major. (Examples: Ag Education, Ag Business, Agronomy, Animal Science, Horticulture, etc.)
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic achievement, financial need, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$450 scholarship.**

Adam E. Huelskamp Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021 - NEW**

- ◆ A high school senior who resides in the school districts of Shelby, Auglaize or Mercer County, Ohio.
- ◆ A 4H or FFA member for a minimum of 4 years combined and must be participating in their final year of eligibility.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated community and school service, financial need, employment history, and an additional essay of no less than 100 words and no more than 200 words on a designated topic.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship.**

Countywide

Elaine Laughlin Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ Shelby County residents who are high school seniors maintaining a high school GPA of no less than 3.6.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Awards for 2021: Two \$1,000 scholarships.**

Education Related

Vera DoLean Ginn Kiwanis Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A Shelby County resident pursuing a career in elementary education. Must have a high school or college GPA of no less than 3.5 and are pursuing a certificate or an Associate's, Bachelor's or Master's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Intent to pursue the field of elementary education, financial need, academic ability, community and school service, recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: Two \$1,000 scholarships.**

First generation college student

Layton Family Foundation Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ **Shelby County resident who is a U.S. citizen and is a senior attending a high school in Shelby County.**
- ◆ Applicants must be a first generation student (*neither parent has a bachelor's degree or higher*), maintains a high school GPA not less than 2.5 and will be enrolling as a full-time student at a trade school, college or university in the coming year.
- ◆ Selection based, in order of priority: Academic ability and an additional essay on a designated topic, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$1,000 scholarship.**

Parent is an employee of Sidney Electric or Area Energy and Electric

Herbert H. & Antoinette V. Schlater Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A parent must be employed by either Sidney Electric Co. or Area Energy & Electric for a minimum of two years prior to January 1, 2020.
- ◆ Preference is given to a graduating high school senior; however, an older student may apply. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0. This requirement will not apply if the applicant has not attended high school or a post-secondary college within the last two years. Must be enrolling in adult education, a trade school or pursuing a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need; academic ability; community, religious, and school service; recommendations.
- ◆ **Awards for 2021: One \$2,500 to a Sidney Electric Co. employee's child and one \$2,500 scholarship to an Area Energy & Electric employee's child.**

Sports Specific Participation

IUTIS Club Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 11, 2021**

- ◆ A high school senior who participated in the IUTIS Club boys' softball program for at least four years.
- ◆ Selection based, in order of priority: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited college or university.
- ◆ **Award for 2021: One \$500 scholarship.**
