College Credit Plus

Ohio's dual enrollment opportunity for eligible students in grades 7-12

- Earn high school & college credit concurrently
- Promotes college & career readiness
- Highly transferable courses
- Accessible course offerings
 - High school (if available), online, & ESCC campuses
- Courses can satisfy high school graduation requirements



Cost to Participate

Participation is **FREE**

- **No application fee**
- **No assessment fee**
- **Tuition & textbooks are included**
- **Consumable supplies purchased by student**
- **Financial risk for failed/withdrawn courses**

Public School Students

- Participation is **FREE** within funding limits

Non-public & Homeschool Students

- Must apply for funding (annually)
- Awarded credit hour amount may vary each year



Course Options

Eligible students may take up to 30 credit hours per academic year (summer, fall, spring)

- Dependent on number of non-CCP courses taken at HS
 - $30 - (\text{secondary school units} \times 3) = \text{CH available for year}$

Course Registration Limits

- Prerequisites must be met prior to registration
- "First 15" Rule
 - Must complete 15 CH level I before progressing to level II
- Course Exclusions
 - Private instruction, remedial/developmental, physical education, study abroad, high fees, sectarian
- CCP Probation





Course Content

CCP Courses = College Courses
Content consistent regardless of location & enrolled student population

Courses may include mature subject matter

- **Potential for graphic, explicit, violent, or sexual nature**

Parent Permission Slip

- **Complete through admission portal**

Mature Content Questionnaire in application

- **Verify necessary social & emotional maturity**
- **Verify readiness to accept responsibility & independence necessary of college classroom**

Review course descriptions, syllabi, & required materials online

Grades

**Grades are recorded on high school
AND college transcripts**

- **3, 4, 5 CH = 1 Carnegie Unit**



Self Pay

Must inform prior to drop deadline if grade should not be included on HS transcript



Lasting Impacts

Permanent college record, impacts HS & college GPA, athletic eligibility, financial aid eligibility



Failing or Withdrawing

Probation & dismissal: state guidelines for underperforming students
Financial responsibility: reimbursement to HS for associated costs

Establish Eligibility

Program Eligibility

Edison State offers 3 options for establishing CCP program eligibility...

1

3.0 GPA

Students with a cumulative, unweighted HIGH SCHOOL GPA of 3.0 or higher

2

2.75 GPA + Relevant HS Coursework

Students with a cumulative, unweighted HS GPA of 2.75-2.99 with a grade of "A" or "B" in at least one of the following HS courses:

- English 10 or higher
- Algebra II or higher
- Any AP Course
- Junior-level career technical course

3

College-Ready Assessment Scores

Students that meet college-ready assessment scores in at least ONE area

- Accuplacer: 250 Reading or 263 Math
- ACT: 18 English, 22 Reading, 22 Math

The academic records submitted in your application portal will be evaluated for CCP program & course eligibility criteria

Establish Eligibility

Course Eligibility

Common course prerequisites at Edison State include...

1

No prerequisites

Program acceptance is all that's needed to enroll

2

ENGLISH ready

Required for English composition 1 & common for many general education courses

- 2.75 GPA + A or B in English 10 or higher
- Accuplacer - reading score 250+
- ACT - reading score 22+

3

MATH ready

Required for college algebra, trigonometry, & precalculus

- 2.75 GPA + A or B in Algebra II or higher
- Accuplacer - AAF 263+
- ACT - math 22+

4

STATS ready

Required for quantitative reasoning, statistics, & some science courses

- Accuplacer - QRAS 263+
- ACT - math 20+ (must establish program eligibility first)

Course Registration

**Registration occurs each semester
(summer, fall, spring)**

Courses on campus or online

- **CCP registration form**
- **All requests require counselor authorization**
- **Must be submitted prior to start of term**

Courses at partnering high schools

- **CCP registration form or batch registration/rosters**

CCP students must follow ESCC registration timelines for all schedule changes

- **Add, Drop, Withdraw**

- Available to students after first course registration

- **Course adjustments**
 - Format, content, & pace
- **FERPA**
 - Privacy rights transition to student
 - Shift in parental role
- **Communication**
 - Parent, counselor, college faculty & staff
- **Planning**
 - Defining goals, establishing a career pathway, degree completion plan
- **Transition After High School**
 - Scholarships & waivers at ESCC
 - Sending official transcript
