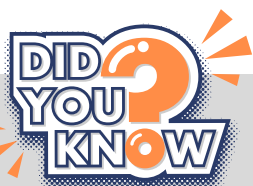

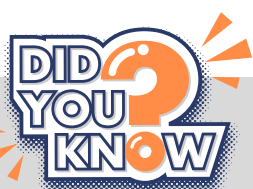

## Tuition Exchange Programs

These programs are offered as agreements between public universities in some states to waive the out-of-state tuition requirements for students from specific states and/or who want to study in majors not offered in their home state.

- Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE): 16 western states offer non-resident tuition discount exchanges to more than 160 participating schools for students from participating states.
- Academic Common Market (ACM): A tuition exchange in 15 southeastern states to secure in-state tuition rates for specific out-of-state degree programs not offered in the home state.
- Midwest Student Exchange: 8 states agree to offer discounted tuition to students from the other states in the exchange at a selection of both public and private schools.
- Tuition Break: This New England-based tuition exchange offers reduce tuition for approved programs at public schools in the six participating states
